RESOLUTION NO. 85-SW-08

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A REVISED FEE STRUCTURE FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AT COUNTY DISPOSAL FACILITIES; INCREASING CERTAIN COUNTY SOLID WASTE FEES; PROVIDING AN ECONOMIC IMPACT DETERMINATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County is authorized to establish, operate, and maintain a waste collection and disposal system within the County pursuant to Ch. 69-1371, §6, Laws of Fla. (1969).

2. The Board is also authorized to prescribe, fix, establish and collect fees, rentals, or other charges for the facilities and services furnished by such waste collection and disposal system, or any part thereof.

3. The Board of County Commissioners last adopted a revised fee level and structure for solid waste disposal at County disposal facilities (hereinafter "tipping fees") on October 27, 1981.

4. Because of increased costs, the Board finds it necessary to increase fees within its fee structure and to revise the structure itself.

5. The Board authorized, scheduled, and publicized a public hearing to consider the adoption of the revised tipping fees in accordance with Ch. 69-1371, §6(4), Laws of Fla. (1969) and Sec. 15-16, Orange County Code.

ACCORDINGLY BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Revised Tipping Fee Charge Schedule.

The Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the revised tipping fee levels and structure attached to and incorporated in this Resolution as Exhibit "A". The attached schedule supersedes and hereby repeals the presently existing tipping fee schedule adopted October 27, 1981.

Section 2. Economic Impact Determination. The Board does hereby determine and find, pursuant to Section 1-27(2)(b), Orange County Code, that sufficient information has been provided for the Board to assess the economic impact of this Resolution on the development of real property in Orange County. The Board does

hereby determine and find no further economic impact statement or economic impact information is required in this matter.

Section 3. Severability of Provisions. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on July 1, 1985.
