A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 83-SW-10 REMOVING THE RIVERSIDE-MEADOWBROOK SERVICE AREA FROM THOSE AREAS DESIGNATED UNDER THE WATER SERVICE ALLOCATION RULES; DESIGNATING AN INTERIM PROCEDURE TO OBTAIN WATER SERVICE CAPACITY IN THE RIVERSIDE-MEADOWBROOK SERVICE AREA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County has adopted the Orange County Water Service Allocation Rules by Ordinance on July 18, 1983.

2. The Board has adopted Resolution No. 83-SW-10 on July 18, 1983 designated the Oak Meadows Service Area and the Riverside-Meadowbrook Service Area as particular service areas to which the Board intended to provide and allocate water service capacity created by the construction or expansion of potable water facilities.

3. Major improvements to the water system in the Riverside-Meadowbrook Service Area have been completed and sufficient water service capacity now exists to the extent that the Board intends to remove the Riverside-Meadowbrook Service Area from the restrictions of the Orange County Water Service Allocation Rules.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The Board hereby amends Resolution 83-SW-10 to remove the Riverside-Meadowbrook Service Area, described in Exhibit "A" attached to and incorporated in this resolution, from those designated areas which are subject to the Orange County Water Service Allocation Rules.

Section 2. The Board hereby establishes the procedure for obtaining water service capacity in the Riverside-Meadowbrook Service Area to be as follows: Application by property owner and payment of the capacity demand portion of the connection fee in accordance with Orange County Rate Resolutions and Ordinances, prior to receiving construction plan approval. This procedure shall remain in effect until water rules are adopted by ordinance for the Riverside-Meadowbrook Service Area.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE NORTHWEST WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICE AREA ALLOCATION RULES; PROVIDING A SHORT TITLE, AUTHORITY, FINDINGS, AND INTENT; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE; PROVIDING WASTEWATER PERMITTEES' EXEMPTION FROM WATER CAPACITY RULES; CREATING WASTEWATER CAPACITY RULES; CREATING A NORTHWEST SEWER PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR SEWER CAPITAL CHARGES, SEWER PERMIT APPLICATIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR ALLOCATION AND TRANSFER OF SEWER SERVICE CAPACITY; PROVIDING FOR SEWER PERMIT DURATION AND RETURN OF UNUSED CAPACITY; CREATING WATER CAPACITY RULES; PROVIDING FOR THE APPLICATION OF THE WATER CAPACITY RULES; CREATING A NORTHWEST WATER PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR WATER CONNECTION FEES, WATER PERMIT APPLICATIONS, AND ALLOCATION AND TRANSFER OF WATER SERVICE CAPACITY; PROVIDING FOR DURATION OF THE WATER PERMIT; ASSIGNING RESPONSIBILITY FOR TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION COSTS TO THE PERMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR RATIFICATION; ECONOMIC IMPACT DETERMINATION; SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
