2 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY,  
4 FLORIDA ADOPTING A WASTEWATER MASTER  
5 PLAN AND WATER MASTER PLAN.

6 WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statute 163.3177(6)(c),  
7 Orange County is required to adopt a general sanitary sewer  
8 and potable water element; and

9 WHEREAS, the policies contained within Orange County's  
10 Water and Sewer element reference the adoption of master  
11 plans for the collection and treatment of wastewater as well  
12 as for the provision of potable water; and

13 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners previously  
14 accepted the Wastewater Master Plan on April 20, 1987 and the  
15 Water Master Plan on April 27, 1987; and

16 WHEREAS, the Local Planning Agency for Orange determined  
17 on June 3, 1987 that the Water and Wastewater Plans are  
18 consistent with Orange County's Growth Management Policy;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
20 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

21 Section 1. The Orange County Wastewater Master Plan  
22 initially accepted by the Board of County Commissioners on  
23 April 20, 1987 is hereby formally adopted as the official  
24 master plan for the provision of wastewater services in  
25 Orange County, Florida.

26 Section 2. The Orange County Water Master Plan  
27 initially accepted by the Board of County Commissioners on  
28 April 27, 1987 is hereby formally adopted as the official  
29 master plan for the provision of water services in Orange  
30 County, Florida.

31 Section 3. These plans shall provide guidance to the  
32 Board of County Commissioners in deciding on construction,  
33 rehabilitation, or extensions of the County water and  
34 wastewater systems. The plans shall specifically govern the  
35 determination as to which public or private entity shall be
