RESOLUTION NO. 94-SW-03

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL; ADOPTING A REVISED FEE STRUCTURE FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AT COUNTY DISPOSAL FACILITIES; INCORPORATING THE ADOPTION OF A COMMERCIAL CLASS I WASTE AND COMMERCIAL BLUE BAG SURCHARGE AND SPECIAL SORTING FEE RATES HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County (the "Board") is authorized to establish, operate, and maintain a waste collection and disposal system within the Orange County pursuant to Section 32-16, Orange County Code.

2. The Board is also authorized to prescribe, fix, establish and collect fees, rentals, or other charges for the facilities and services furnished by such waste collection and disposal system, or any part thereof.

3. The Board last adopted a revised fee level and structure for solid waste disposal at County disposal facilities (hereinafter "tipping fees") on January 18, 1994, pursuant to Resolution 94-SW-01.

4. The Board finds it necessary to revise the current rate structure by incorporating a Commercial Class I Waste, Commercial Blue Bag Surcharge and Special Sorting Fee rates therein.

5. The Board authorized, scheduled, and publicized a public hearing to consider the adoption of the revised tipping fees in accordance with Section 32-16, Orange County Code.

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Revised Tipping Fee Charge Schedule.

The Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the revised tipping fee structure attached to and incorporated in this Resolution as Exhibit "A". The attached schedule supersedes and hereby repeals the presently existing tipping fee schedule adopted January 18, 1994. Said revised rate structure is made pursuant to that certain rate study and report prepared by HDR Engineering, Inc. and Dunn & Associates and dated August 3, 1994.

Section 2. Severability of Provisions. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on January 1, 1995.

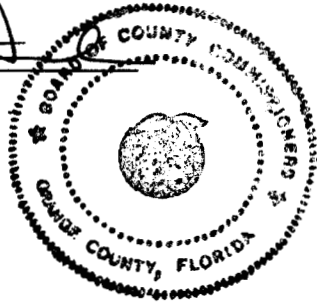

Loads delivered in Family Vehicles, Station Wagons, Passenger Vans	prevailing per ton rate
Pick-Up Trucks without Side Boards or Trailers	prevailing per ton rate
Pick-Up Trucks with Trailer Loads	prevailing per ton rate
Uncovered Loads surcharge	(1)
Minimum Charge	\$5.25

(1) Charged at 2 times the rate for covered loads of the appropriate class of waste.
