RESOLUTION NO. 96-S-04

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 96-S-03
REPEALING THE AUTOMATIC THREE PERCENT
INCREASE FOR WASTEWATER SYSTEM CHARGES
FOR FISCAL YEAR 1997; PROVIDING FOR
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. Pursuant to Resolution 96-S-03 a three percent increase in Wastewater and Pollution Control Charges is scheduled to take effect on October 1, 1996 for the fiscal year 1997.
2. The Utilities Division of Orange County, Florida has reviewed the current rates and has determined that the existing rates are sufficient to adequately operate the wastewater system for the fiscal year 1997.
3. Based upon this review, the Utilities Division recommends that the automatic three percent (3%) increase in rates for fiscal year 1997 is not necessary and should be repealed.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The automatic three percent (3%) annual rate increase in Wastewater and Pollution Control Charges scheduled to take effect on October 1, 1996 for fiscal year 1997 pursuant to Resolution No. 96-S-03 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Resolution 96-S-03 shall continue in full force and effect in all other respects and unless future resolutions are adopted, the automatic annual increase shall resume as provided on October 1, 1997 for fiscal year 1998.

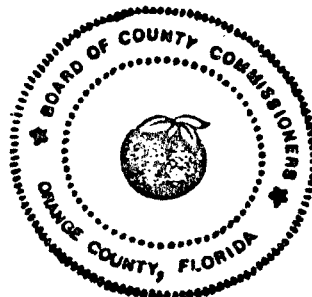
Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

CONSERVATION CHARGE

A Conservation Charge is hereby adopted to promote water usage conservation. The Conservation Charge shall be 1.5 times the volume charge for water usage over 15,000 gallons per month of any 3/4-inch by 5/8-inch water meter.

BILLING PERIODS

Monthly: Single family residential, duplex, condominium, and other type dwelling units individually metered; multifamily residential apartment, mobile home, travel-trailer, and other type dwelling units collectively metered; and all other commercial, institutional, industrial or other accounts (e.g., large consumers), regardless of meter size, shall be billed for the amount of water used each month as measured by each of their respective meters. (The above rates shall apply to each meter, regardless of the number of meters.)
