County Mayor Jacobs and Commissioner Clarke, along with the Mayor of Maitland, and representatives from Apopka, Maitland, Ocoee, Orlando, Reedy Creek Improvement District, Winter Garden, and Winter Park attended a meeting regarding the Solid Waste Study.

Ms. Remudo-Fries thanked all of the participants in the Solid Waste Study and announced this would be the last Solid Waste Mayor's group meeting.

Mr. Kowalski presented information regarding operational efficiencies, reduction of costs, stabilization of waste flows, comprehensive services such as Class I and II landfills and waste transfer stations, tipping fees, and long-term care cost stabilization. He concluded his presentation with recommendations adopting new tipping fees, combining Class III into Class I, and evaluating commercial waste non-exclusive franchising.


Discussion ensued.


