It is ordered by the Board that A. H. Statth Clerk be paid the sum of seventy one dollars and nine cents for services rendered as Clerk of the Board and other services as per bill filed for the years 1868, & 1869, and that the Clerk be authorized to issue a certificate to that effect bearing 8 percent interest from this date.

It is ordered by the Board that David McGill and John Sauner be paid the sum of thirty dollars each for services as County Commissioners ten days services at 300 per day and the Clerk be authorized to issue certificates to each for that amount being 8 percent interest from this date.

It is ordered by the Board that Hugh G. Parlen be paid the sum of twenty seven dollars as County Commissioner for nine days service at three dollars per day, also also the sum of twelve dollars for 24 lunches for Court House at two dollars each and the Clerk be authorized to issue a certificate bearing 8 percent interest from this date.

It is ordered that the sum of seventy five dollars be paid to D. W. McGill Sheriff for 10 days attendance on Board County Commissioners at 5⁰⁰ per day, also executing 3 writs facias for County Court - at 15⁰⁰ each and the Clerk be authorized to issue a certificate bearing 8 percent interest.

It is ordered by the Board that E. H. Spain be paid the sum of twenty three dollars and seventy two cents for Stationery furnished the County and Provisions furnished guard and the Trust Clerk be authorized to issue a certificate bearing 9 per cent interest for that amount.

It having been brought to the notice of the Board that Thomas Kemeth being a delinquent as to making the road and that he had paid his fine in County scrip said fine legally belonging to the school fund It is ordered that the County of orange do one and twenty dollars in addition to the school fund in the sum of four dollars and ninety three cents and the amount due on the scrip be paid to John R. Mizell for collecting fine as above and that the old scrip be destroyed and the Clerk be authorized to issue a scrip to the amount of three dollars and ninety three cents the balance of the old scrip.

It is ordered that the Board do now adjourn
