TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the April 2017 hotel collection month were \$24,291,100. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that April 2017 collections were 15.8% higher than April 2016. "The April TDT numbers showed a huge increase from last year's numbers. With Easter being in April, along with spring break, and the opening of the Race Through New York Ride at Universal, it's no wonder why TDT collections were so much higher. I hope the May results will also show significant growth with all the great new attractions that are opening up," stated Diamond.
