TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of August 2013 were \$13,313,500. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that August 2013 collections were 9% higher than August 2012. "Another good increase over the same month last year," Haynie stated. "This will be the fourth straight month of growth since April. Let's hope it continues."
