## TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of August 2014 were \$14,845,400. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that August 2014 collections were nearly 11% higher than August 2013. "This is another nice increase over the same month last year. At this point, with only one month left to report in fiscal year 2014, we are 7% ahead of last fiscal year. This is all very good news," stated Haynie.
