TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of August 2016 were \$16,490,300. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie indicated that August 2016 collections were 3% higher than August 2015. "With just one month left in our fiscal year, we are on track for FY 15-16 to be another record-breaking year for this all important revenue," stated Haynie.
