TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the August 2017 hotel collection month were \$17,340,500. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that August 2017 collections were 4.7% higher than August 2016. "July was a little slower than usual but August was better. People may be getting in their last chance at a family vacation before sending the kids back to school," stated Diamond.
