TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of December 2013 were \$16,156,800. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that December 2013 collections were 4% higher than December 2012. "This is still a strong showing and a good way to wrap up the calendar year," Haynie stated.
