## TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of December 2015 were \$20,573,800. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie indicated that December 2015 collections were over 12% higher than December 2014. "Collections for December were stronger than expected. In fact, this is the first time December collections have exceeded \$20 million" stated Haynie.
