TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of December 2016 were \$20,086,700. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that December 2016 collections were 3.5% lower than December 2015. "I had hoped that we would see tourist tax revenue increases like we saw last month. Unfortunately, just like Punxsutawney Phil saw his shadow today, there was a shadow over December 2016 tax collections. This is a reminder that tourist tax collections will fluctuate from month to month," stated Diamond.
