TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the December 2017 hotel collection month were \$23,072,700. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that December 2017 collections were 14.6% higher than December 2016. "I thought that there was a good chance that we would close out 2017 with a strong December. However, December clearly surpassed our expectations," stated Diamond.
