TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of February 2013 were \$16,298,800. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that February 2013 collections were 3% higher than February 2012. "February's positive growth reflects our hospitality industry's continuous recovery," Haynie stated. "It's good to see that we are maintaining a positive trend."
