ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of February 2015 were \$19,751,400. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that February 2015 collections were 11% higher than February 2014. "Be nice to tourists because they are being very nice to us," stated Haynie.
