ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax

collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of February 2016

ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

were \$20,815,100. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and

motels.

Comptroller Haynie indicated that February 2016 collections were over 5% higher than

February 2015. "The resort tax continues to demonstrate its resilience, and the importance of

our hospitality industry. As people are beginning to contemplate possible future projects,

however, I will be reminding everyone of how quickly and unexpectedly the growth trend can

reverse," stated Haynie.
