TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of February 2017 were \$21,825,000. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that February 2017 collections were 4.3% higher than February 2016. "It is good to see that tourist development tax collections increased by almost \$900,000 over February 2016. That is two straight months of increases. Let's hope that will continue over the months to come," stated Diamond.
