TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the January 2018 hotel collection month were \$23,707,800. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that January 2018 collections were 14.7% higher than January 2017. "We all hope for a strong economy. This is a great way to start the new year," stated Diamond.
