TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of July 2013 were \$15,244,800. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that July 2013 collections were 5% higher than July 2012. "This will help the County in meeting its current financial obligations," Haynie stated. "As it looks, we are headed towards a strong finish for the fiscal year, and preserving our financially conscientious reserve is still a top priority."
