TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the July 2018 TDT collection month were \$21,669,200. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that July 2018 collections were 7.3% higher than July 2017. "Summertime is a busy time of the year for Orlando tourism. So, it was good to see such a solid increase in the TDT numbers for July," stated Diamond.
