TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of June 2013 were \$17,390,200. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that June 2013 collections were 10% higher than June 2012. "As the community enjoys our busy summer months and resort tax reflects year over year growth, everyone may think the County now has 'extra' cash," Haynie stated. "However, they should remember that Orange County is saving up to pay for more than \$187 million in upgrades and refurbishments to the Orange County Convention Center, while it remains solely responsible for meeting its significant contractual obligations to bondholders, Visit Orlando, and the City of Orlando, among others. We simply cannot risk depleting our reserves without very thoughtful consideration of the longer term impacts."
