ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of June 2014 were \$17,960,700. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that June 2014 collections were just over 3% higher than June 2013. "At the three quarters mark, we are almost 7% ahead of our last fiscal year, and we expect the excitement of Diagon Alley will boost the remaining summer months even higher," stated Haynie.
