ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax

collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of March 2017

were \$27,484,600. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that March 2017 collections were 2.7% higher than March

2016. "Seasonal variations, such as the timing of spring breaks and Easter vacations can

cause month to month comparisons to be slightly misleading. Last year, Easter fell in March.

This year it fell in April. Even with this, collections for March were up over last year. I am

looking forward to seeing April's numbers," stated Diamond.
