ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax

collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of May 2015

were \$17,678,200. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and

motels.

Comptroller Haynie indicated that May 2015 collections were almost 9% higher than May

2014. "Resort tax collections continue to demonstrate the strength of our hospitality

industry," stated Haynie.
