TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the November 2017 hotel collection month were \$21,759,600. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that November 2017 collections were 6.9% higher than November 2016. "It is great to see TDT collections continue to come in above projections," stated Diamond.
