TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA – Orange County Comptroller Phil Diamond announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by Orange County for the October 2017 hotel collection month were \$21,828,000. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Diamond indicated that October 2017 collections were 6.0% higher than October 2016. "Orange County and our region were still feeling the impacts from Hurricanes Irma and Maria during the month of October and I am certain that influenced our TDT numbers. As we go into the holiday season, the numbers should be closer to normal," stated Diamond.
