## TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of September 2014 were \$13,755,700. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that September 2014 collections were nearly 17% higher than September 2013. "Our 2014 fiscal year is ending with a bang, as September's collections are almost 17% higher than September 2013. The year's total collections outpaced the prior year by nearly 8%. Everyone in Central Florida, visitors and residents alike, will continue to enjoy the wonderful facilities paid for, in whole or in large part, with the resort taxes," stated Haynie.
