The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$15,000 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purposes:

Contributions:

1. **Boy Scouts of America, Central Florida Council – \$5,000.** The Boy Scouts of America's mission is to provide at-risk youth who desperately need guidance and role models with a quality scouting program that will enable them to recognize and reach their full potential by making the right choices to accomplish their goals, to see what they can become through making the right choices, by working hard and opening their eyes to possibilities of a more constructive lifestyle.
2. **Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Florida – \$5,000.** These forfeiture funds will be utilized to inspire and enable all young people, especially those from disadvantaged circumstances, to realize their full potential as productive, caring and responsible citizens. By reaching children at an early age and providing positive activities and encouragement, Boys and Girls Clubs provide a compelling alternative to youth crime, gang membership, drugs, and other negative influences that affect our youth today.
3. **Harbor House – \$5,000.** Harbor House is committed to providing comprehensive services to victims of domestic violence and provides domestic violence education to Central Florida communities. Some of the services they provide include a temporary safe shelter; a 24-hour crisis hotline; child, teen and adult counseling; as well as acting as an advocate on court and legal issues for thousands of victims of domestic violence each year.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$15,000 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to the Boys Scouts of America, Central Florida Council (\$5,000), Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Florida (\$5,000), and Harbor House (\$5,000).

PLEASE NOTE: The Board voted to establish spending limits of 20% for this fund for contributions. At this point in the year, contributions represent 10% of the total expenditures; however, the restriction applies to total expenditures for the year, at year-end. The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.

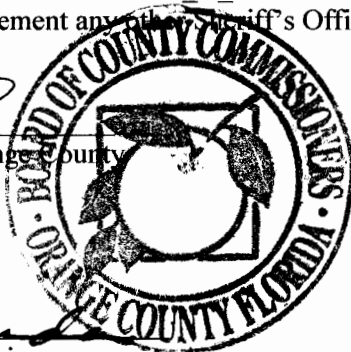

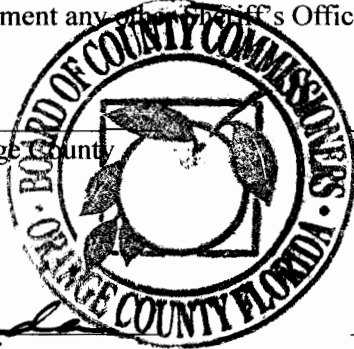
