Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$1,500 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purposes:

Contributions:

- 1. Florida Missing Children's Day Foundation, Inc. – \$500.** This charitable organization will be honoring law enforcement officers and citizens who have assisted in missing child cases. They plan to raise statewide awareness to help prevent child abduction and sexual exploitation during their annual Florida Missing Children's Day ceremonies scheduled for 2014.
- 2. Young Fathers of Central Florida - \$1,000.** This organization has been part of the Central Florida community since 2006. Their programs are focused on responsible fatherhood and improving the lives of community members in the areas of crime prevention, safer neighborhoods, and drug abuse education and prevention.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$1,500 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to the Florida Missing Children's Day Foundation, Inc. (\$500) and Young Fathers of Central Florida (\$1,000).

PLEASE NOTE: The Board voted to establish spending limits of 20% for this fund for contributions. At this point in the year, contributions represent 10% of the total expenditures; however, the restriction applies to total expenditures for the year, at year-end. The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.
