Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$407,557.30 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purposes:

**Sheriff's Equipment:**

- 1. Range Video Equipment - \$121,087.30.** These funds will be used to purchase a video camera system to capture all the open area of the Orange County Sheriff's Office Range. Additional cameras will be mounted to the main office building to capture the parking lot and obstacle course.
- 2. MX-10 FLIR System - \$284,970.** These funds will be used to purchase a MX-10 FLIR system. This system can incorporate several different types of sensors (up to six), including high-definition daylight and night infrared sensors. This purchase will replace the FLIR 1175, which is failing and due to its age cannot be adequately repaired to be of full use.

**Contribution:**

**The Foundation for Early Childhood Development - \$1,500.** This program is designed to provide information to parents for child care resources, as well as manage the School Readiness Programs for children up to 12 years old and the Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten programs that provide free access to education for all eligible four year olds.

**ACTION REQUESTED:** Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$407,557.30 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund to purchase Range Video Equipment (\$121,087.30), MX-10 FLIR System (\$284,970), and a contribution to The Foundation for Early Childhood Development (\$1,500).

**PLEASE NOTE:** The Board voted to establish spending limits of 20% for this fund for contributions. At this point in the year, contributions represent 5% of the total expenditures; however, the restriction applies to total expenditures for the year, at year-end. The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.

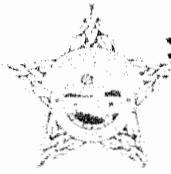
