SUBJECT: Appointment/Reappointments to Pine Hills Local Government
Neighborhood Improvement District Advisory Council
CONSENT AGENDA ITEM JULY 29, 2014

On December 20, 2012, the Board adopted Ordinance 2011-21 creating the Pine Hills Local Government Neighborhood Improvement District Advisory Council (the "Council"). The ordinance became effective December 30, 2011. The ordinance designates two seats on the Council for representatives nominated by the Mayor, one seat for a representative nominated by the District 2 Commissioner, one seat for a representative nominated by the District 6 Commissioner, two seats for representatives nominated by the Pine Hills Community Council, and one seat for a representative nominated by the Pine Hills Safe Neighborhood Partnership. Representatives must be property owners or residents within the boundaries of the Pine Hills Local Government Neighborhood Improvement District and registered Orange County voters. The Board appoints all Council members. Terms are for three years.

There is one vacancy in the Mayor's representative category due to the resignation of Allie Braswell, Jr., and the terms of Luis A. Cordero, Frantz S. De Milord, Shabana Khublal, and Carolyn Wilson have expired. Mayor Jacobs has nominated Shabana Khublal for reappointment and Nicole Farquharson for appointment to succeed Allie Braswell, Jr. Commissioner Moore Russell has nominated Carolyn Wilson for reappointment and the Pine Hills Safe Neighborhood Partnership has nominated Luis A. Cordero for reappointment. Attached is a list of the current members of the Council that indicates the districts in which the members reside, the categories in which they are serving, and the expiration of their terms.

A copy of Ms. Farquharson's advisory board application for appointment is available upon request. If you require further information, please let me know.

ACTION REQUESTED: Reappointment to the Pine Hills Local Government Neighborhood Improvement District Advisory Council of Shabana Khublal in the Mayor's representative category, Carolyn Wilson in the District 6 representative category, and Luis A. Cordero in the Pine Hills Safe Neighborhood Partnership representative category with terms expiring June 30, 2017; and the appointment of Nicole Farquharson in the Mayor's representative category with a term expiring June 30, 2015.
