





ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y14-1070-LC, Furnish Asphalt Products, to the low responsive and responsible bidders, Hubbard Construction Company, in the estimated contract award amount of \$2,714,750 for a 1-year term. Further request authorization for the Purchasing and Contracts Division to renew the contract for two additional 1-year periods.

PROCUREMENT:

Asphalt products for Roads and Drainage Division as required to support roadway maintenance and construction.
