SUBJECT: Approval of Contract Y15-2060, Prenatal Care

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Contract Y15-2060, Prenatal Care, with Florida Department of Health Orange County, for a 1-year period in the annual amount of \$1,400,000.

PROCUREMENT:

The program will provide comprehensive prenatal care designed to identify patients who are pregnant, encourage early and ongoing prenatal care, and increase patient's member's access to perinatal information. Funding will support the provision of comprehensive prenatal care by a licensed obstetrician to uninsured, underinsured and medically indigent residents of Orange County.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001-060-2502-3167.

APPROVALS:

The Health Services Department concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

This program will include the services typically provided by an obstetrics practice in the local medical community. Prenatal care is to be delivered in an obstetric clinic and will be provided by a licensed obstetrician/nurse practitioner/nurse midwife. Prenatal care includes; the initial exam, all prenatal visits performed at medically appropriate intervals up to the date of delivery, routine prenatal laboratories during the prenatal period, sonograms, care for pregnancy related conditions (e.g. nausea, vomiting, cystitis, vaginitis) and post-partum check-ups. Case management will be provided to patients if identified with high-risk pregnancies. A risk appraisal for pregnant women will be completed for all pregnant patients.
