

Fourth Amendment to Interlocal for Fire Protection and Rescue
Services

Since 1983, Orange County and Belle Isle have had an agreement whereby the county has provided fire and emergency rescue services to the city's residents. In 2002, the parties entered into a First Amendment, in October 2011, a Second Amendment between the parties was executed and in Aug 2013 the parties entered into a Third Amendment. This Fourth Amendment allows for fire safety inspection services to be performed by Orange County within the City of Belle Isle.

This agreement provides certainty and stability regarding Orange County Fire Rescue service for the Belle Isle area.

**ORANGE COUNTY/BELLE ISLE
FOURTH AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
FOR
FIRE PROTECTION AND RESCUE SERVICES**

This Fourth Amendment (“Fourth Amendment”) to the Orange County/Belle Isle Interlocal Agreement for Fire Protection and Rescue Services (“Interlocal Agreement”) is made and entered into as of the date of last execution hereof, by and between Orange County, Florida, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida (“County”) and the City of Belle Isle, Florida, a municipal corporation created and existing under the laws of the State of Florida (“City”).

WHEREAS, County and City previously entered into an Interlocal Agreement dated February 7, 1983; and

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2002, the parties entered into a First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement; and on October 4, 2011, the parties entered into a Second Amendment to Interlocal Agreement; and on August 6, 2013 the parties entered into a Third Amendment to Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire by this Fourth Amendment, to add the cooperation provision to provide certainty and stability to the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, County and City agree to amend the Interlocal Agreement as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 6 of the Interlocal Agreement entitled “Cooperation” is hereby added to read as follows:

Cooperation

6. To facilitate performance of this Interlocal Agreement, the City shall fully cooperate with and assist Orange County. The City hereby grants to Orange County full power and authority to enforce the Fire Prevention Code. This authority specifically includes, but is not limited to, inspection of buildings, lands and premises, except for single-family dwellings and the usual appurtenances thereto. Orange County agrees to issue notices of violations and other appropriate warnings as part of its services under this Interlocal Agreement, and to notify the mayor of the City of such violations, and cooperate with the City in securing compliance with applicable law.

Section 2. Effective October 1, 2014, the provisions of this Fourth Amendment specifically amend and supersede the provisions of any prior amendments to the Interlocal Agreement. All other terms and provisions of the Interlocal Agreement not specifically modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.
