

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y15-146-MA, Coarse Aggregate, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Cemex Inc., for an estimated contract award amount of \$262,500 for a 1-year contract. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for four additional 1-year terms.

PROCUREMENT:

This contract will provide coarse aggregates to support highway construction and related work throughout the County.

The Roads and Drainage, the Utilities Field Services and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Five bids were received in response to the Invitation for Bids. The bids were evaluated for price, responsiveness and responsibility. Cemex, Inc. is recommended for contract award.
