Subject: Community Action Board Appointments
DISCUSSION AGENDA ITEM JANUARY 6, 2015

The Community Action Board (CAB) is responsible for development, review, supervision, evaluation, and making recommendations for final approval of all fiscal and program policies, plans, priorities, proposals, budgets, and any other activities to be conducted by the Community Action Division. The CAB consists of three sectors: public sector, private sector, and low income community sector.

The Board of County Commissioners appoints the eight members of the public sector, which is composed of up to three County Commissioners, up to three elected officials from three different municipalities located in Orange County, up to two members representing the state of Florida or United States Congress, and one member of the Orange County School Board. There are currently two vacancies for commissioners due to the departure of former Commissioners Brummer (term expires December 31, 2015) and Moore Russell (term expired December 31, 2014). Terms are for four years.

On January 6, 2015, the Board will be asked to appoint two commissioners to the CAB with terms expiring December 31, 2015 and 2018, respectively.
