SUBJECT: Evaluation of Crash Impediment Measures

On April 9, 2014, a car crashed into a KinderCare in east Orange County, tragically resulting in multiple injuries and the death of four-year-old Lily Quintus. As a result, Mayor Jacobs requested a countywide assessment of motor vehicle crashes as a public safety threat to vulnerable or at-risk populations, which include children and senior citizens.

Mayor Jacobs' Crash Impediment Task Force, comprising of County staff from Traffic Engineering, Fire Rescue, Health Services, Building, Code Enforcement, GIS, ISS Systems, and Zoning, conducted extensive research in regards to these types of incidents across the county.

On behalf of this work group, I will be presenting our preliminary research results and findings during the BCC Meeting scheduled on Tuesday, February 10, 2015.

This will be presented as an informational item and no BCC action is required at this time.
