SUBJ: **Adoption of Resolution regarding Adoption Of Form Use Agreements To Be Used With Mandatory And Incorporated Voluntary Homeowners' Associations For The Purpose Of Allowing Crime Prevention Cameras To Be Permitted In Public Rights-Of-Way (the "Resolution").**

On January 13, 2015, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County (the "Board") approved a program that allows crime prevention cameras to be permitted in public rights-of-way of subdivisions with mandatory and incorporated voluntary Homeowners' Associations, subject to entering into a Use Agreement and complying with County ordinances, conditions, regulations, and permitting requirements (the "Security Camera Program").

In order to efficiently and effectively accomplish the goals of the Security Camera Program, it is in the best interests of the County to approve forms of Use Agreements to be used to implement the Security Camera Program and to authorize the Mayor to approve such Use Agreements on behalf of the Board.

The Resolution, if adopted, will approve such form Use Agreements and provide the authority for the Mayor to sign them on behalf of the Board.

Action Requested: Adoption of Resolution of the Orange County Board of County Commissioners regarding Adoption of Form Use Agreements to be used with Mandatory and Incorporated Voluntary Homeowners' Associations for the Purpose of Allowing Crime Prevention Cameras to be Permitted in Public Rights-Of-Way.
