



SUBJECT: Award of Invitation for Bids Y15-196-LC, Hospitalist Group
Services for Corrections Health Services Division

RECOMMENDATION

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y15-196-LC, Hospitalist Group Services for Corrections Health Services Division, to the sole responsive and responsible bidder, David Mazer, MD PA, in the estimated annual contract award amount of \$123,750 for a 1-year term contract. Further request authority for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional 1-year periods. This is an estimated contract amount and the annual usage is uncertain.

PROCUREMENT:

The hospitalist will manage the medical care of all hospitalized inmates, provide greater continuity of care and streamline operations of hospitalization. Services will be provided on a 24-hour, 7-day-per-week basis.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001-081-3806-3275.

APPROVALS:

The Health Services Division and the Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

DISCUSSION

One bid was received in response to this Invitation for Bids. Dr. Mazer has provided these services satisfactorily for the past four contract terms (twelve years). Two other potential bidders, Glampiris, Inc. and Maxim Physician Resources, were queried regarding their failure to compete for award of this contract. Both indicated that they were not interested. The hospitalist works closely with medical providers and case managers to ensure the adequate medical care to inmates. The bid is considered reasonable since it represents a decrease of \$15,000 from the last contract.
