



Non-Emergency Ambulance Transportation

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y15-1018-DG, Non-Emergency Ambulance Transportation, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Falck Southeast II Corp. dba American Ambulance, in the estimated contract amount of \$101,568. Further request authorization to renew the contracts by the Procurement Division for two additional 12-month periods.

PROCUREMENT:

The services provided shall be non-emergency care and ambulance transportation for specific population groups within the correctional complex located at 33rd Street, Orlando, Florida on a twenty-four hour a day, seven days a week basis.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001 081 3806 3220.

APPROVALS:

The Corrections Health Services and Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Two bids were received in response to this solicitation. The bids were evaluated for price, responsiveness and responsibility. Falck Southeast II Corp. dba American Ambulance is the low responsive bidder and has a satisfactory performance record for the same services under a previous county contract.
