SUBJECT: Outdoor Sculpture Exhibition  
**Discussion Agenda Item – April 7, 2015**

The Public Art Review Board with staff support from the Office of Arts and Cultural Affairs has secured private funding for the hosting of a sculpture loan program. This temporary outdoor sculpture program is open to artists who have sculptural pieces of over six feet in height. Four pieces will be selected by the Public Art Review Board, and will be installed on the lawn of the Orange County Administration Building. Arts and Cultural Affairs staff has met with Facilities Operations and Maintenance to identify four sites on the lawn where the sculptures would stand.

Artists were invited to submit their work for this inaugural exhibition, and the sculptures will be rotated out annually, pending renewed sponsorships, with new artworks being selected every year. The Public Art Review Board, along with sponsors, will review applicants and choose sculptures appropriate to the site. Selected artists will transport the artwork to the site, install the artwork with minimal assistance on the specified date, and remove the artwork as requested. The County will provide infrastructure such as concrete pads as necessary.

The installations are expected to occur between June 1 and June 20, 2015. An opening reception is planned for June 27, 2015 to celebrate the art installation.
