

SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment No. 2, Contract Y14-2051, Central Florida Family Health Centers and Amendment No. 2, Contract Y14-2052, Community Health Centers

**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approval of Amendment No. 2, Contract Y14-2051, Central Florida Family Health Centers for an additional estimated annual amount of \$250,000 for a revised total annual contract amount of \$2,525,000 and approval of Amendment No. 2, Contract Y14-2052, Community Health Centers for an additional estimated annual amount of \$100,000 for a revised total annual contract amount of \$2,160,000. Funding for these contracts is via an Intergovernmental Transfer (IGT) Program.

**PROCUREMENT**

To provide obstetrics and gynecology services on the eastside of Orlando and the provision of behavioral health services on the westside of Orlando.

**FUNDING:**

On October 8, 2013 the Board approved Contract Y14-2050, Intergovernmental Transfer (IGT) Program with Orlando Health, Inc. and Adventist Health System in the amount of \$14,349,208. The contract amount is funded by state and federal dollars for the operation of the Primary Care Access Network (PCAN). The hospitals will also support PCAN with direct financial support. These increases will be supported from existing IGT money and do not require any additional county funding.

**APPROVALS**

The Health Services Department concurs with this recommendation.

**REMARKS:**
