

SUBJECT: June 2, 2015 – Discussion Item  
East Central Florida Corridor Task Force Recommendations  
and North Ranch – Osceola County Sector Plan

On November 1, 2013, Governor Scott signed Executive Order 13-319 establishing the East Central Florida Corridor Task Force (ECFCTF). The Order charged the Task Force with evaluating and developing consensus recommendations on future transportation corridors in portions of Brevard, Orange, and Osceola counties. Members included local government representatives, major landowners, environmental stakeholders, and other economic interests in the study area.

Based on economic opportunities for the region, population projections and travel demands between the participating counties, and Osceola County's proposed North Ranch Sector Plan, the ECFCTF recommended 21 guiding principles along with nine corridor alternatives for future study. The final report was submitted to the governor on December 1, 2014.

The Florida Department of Transportation Systems Manager, Huiwei Shen, is the Project Manager working with local governments and agencies on the implementation strategy for the corridor recommendations. She will present on Florida's Future Corridors, specifically those recommended by the ECFCTF. Jeff Jones, Strategic Initiatives Director for Osceola County, will present an update on the North Ranch Sector Plan.
