Honorary Designation of Roadway

Definition

- **A program to honor or memorialize a public safety employee who passed while in the line of duty by designating a section of a county road in their name.**
- **The designation does not officially change the name of the road or the County's 911 addressing system**



Honorary Designation of Roadway

Description of Designation

- **Two 24" X 48" signs – 1 in each direction at start and end of designation limits**
- **In effect for a period of 7 years**





Honorary Designation of Roadway

Location Criteria

- **On a county-maintained collector or arterial in unincorporated Orange County**
- **Preferably within vicinity of home or business of individual honored**
- **Maximum length of 1 mile**
- **Only 1 designation per roadway segment**



Honorary Designation of Roadway

Nomination Criteria

- **A public safety employee who passed while in the line of duty**
- **Was employed by an agency within the jurisdiction of Orange County**
- **Official endorsement by appropriate government agency or authority**
- **Support of family, Mayor's Office, and District Commissioner**



Honorary Designation of Roadway

Procedure

- **Application completed and submitted**
- **Staff committee review with recommendation**
- **BCC Approval**
- **Traffic Engineering to fabricate and install signs**
- **Signs removed and panels given to family or next of kin at end of 7 years unless approved for renewal**
