Hardware and Software to Upgrade Existing Offender Imaging System

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Contract Y16-147-PD, Procurement, Installation and Support of Hardware and Software to Upgrade Existing Offender Imaging System, with Dynamic Imaging Systems, Inc. (DISI, Inc.) in the contract award amount of \$157,634.80 for a two-year contract.

PROCUREMENT:

Installation and 24 x 7 support for the hardware, software and interfaces for the existing offender booking process.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account numbers 1023 081 4009 6438, 1023 081 4009 6440, 1023 081 4009 4123, 1023 081 4009 6410, 1023 081 4009 3820.

APPROVALS:

The Information Systems Services Division and Corrections Department concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

This contract will provide for the procurement, installation and 24 x 7 support for the upgrade of existing hardware, software and interfaces to the existing offender imaging system. The current system was implemented ten years ago and is in need of an upgrade to remain operational on existing and future platforms. All hardware and software components will be replaced.

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The new system will provide electronic interfaces to all Orange County justice partners. Inmate images will be shared with the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to provide facial recognition, criminal history, and photo line-up capabilities.

DISI, Inc. is the only contractor offering this system with the ability to integrate with the County's current jail management system. A sole source statement was issued and posted on the Internet to confirm the sole source nature of this procurement. Orange County Procurement invited other potential contractors to submit information or their ability to provide these services. No responses were received. This price is considered fair and reasonable based on the evaluation and analysis of technical staff.
