ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y16-114-PD, EMS Medication, to the low responsive and responsible bidders, Bound Tree Medical, LLC for line items 1-32, 35-39 and 41 for a 1-year term contract in the total estimated contract award amount of \$1,176,854.50 and Henry Schein, Inc. for line items 33, 34 and 40 for a 1-year term contract in the total estimated contract amount of \$113,180. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for four additional 1-year terms.

PROCUREMENT:

This contract will provide medications to the Fire Rescue Department for the delivery of emergency medical services (EMS).
