SUBJ: **Increase the Posted Speed Limit on Stoneybrook Hills Parkway from 25 Miles Per Hour to 35 Miles Per Hour**

At the request of a concerned citizen, Traffic Engineering staff has evaluated the existing posted speed limit on Stoneybrook Hills Parkway in northwest Orange County. The citizen believes that the existing 25 miles per hour posted speed limit presents a speed trap for motorist traveling this road.

Stoneybrook Hills Parkway between US 441 and Town Hills Boulevard is a 4-lane residential street and is approximately one quarter mile long. A speed study conducted by staff showed that the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed on Stoneybrook Hills Parkway is 39.78 miles per hour.

Based on driving on this roadway and the results of the speed study, staff recommends that the Board approve increasing the posted speed limit on Stoneybrook Hills Parkway from 25 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour.

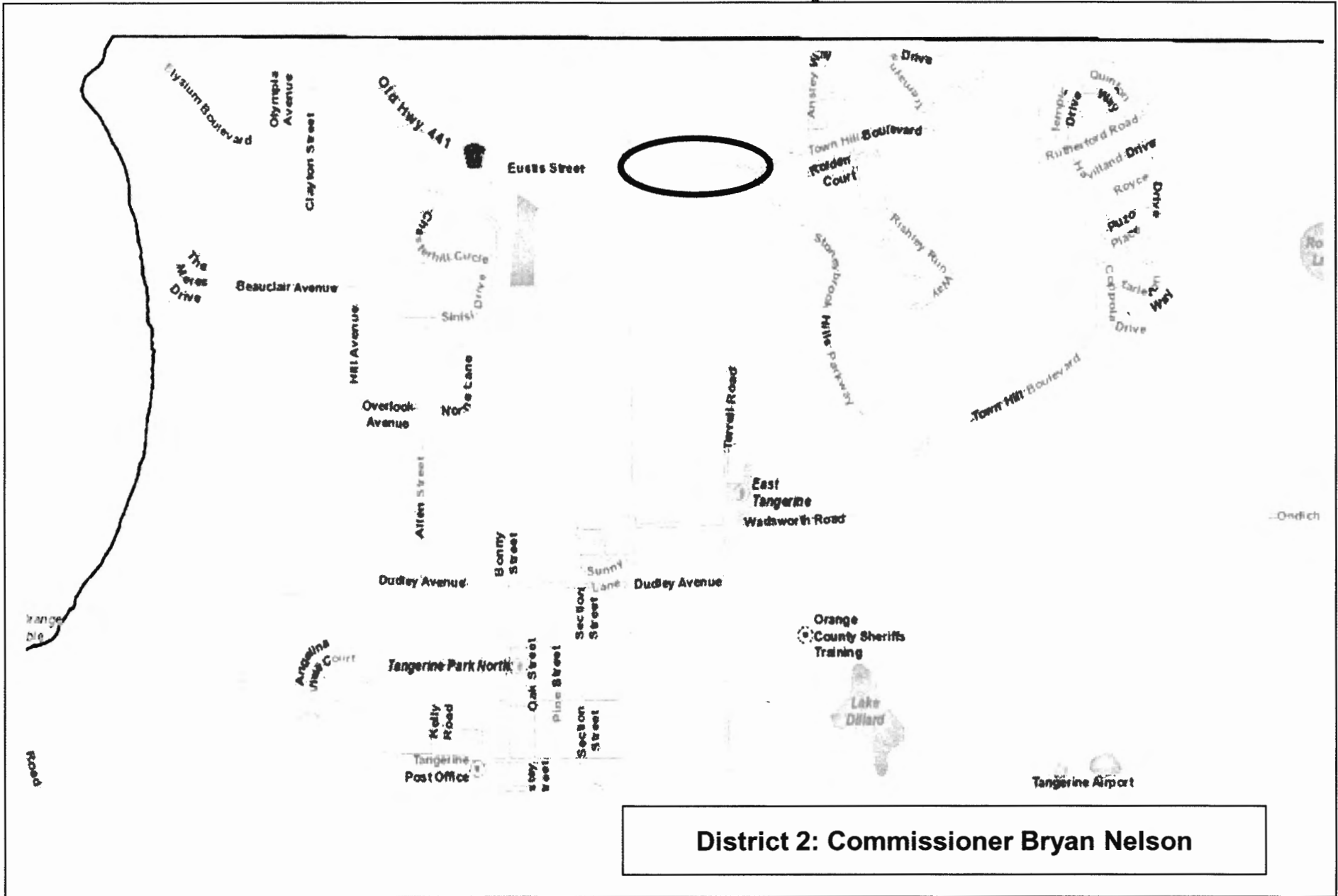
